COVID-19 Vaccination Policy Attestation

Policy

Effective October 1, 2021, as required by *The Public Employers' COVID-19 Emergency Regulations*, the Office of the Provincial Auditor of Saskatchewan (Office) implemented a proof of full COVID-19 vaccination or valid negative COVID-19 test policy. This policy requires all employees, including contractors working for the Office, declare their vaccination status and verify they are either fully vaccinated or provide valid negative COVID-19 test results at least every seven (7) days.

Fully vaccinated means that an individual has received the recommended number of COVID-19 vaccine doses, or combination of COVID-19 vaccines, which were received at least 14 days prior to declaring they are fully vaccinated.

A valid COVID-19 test (a polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test for SARS-CoV-2, a point-of-care antigen test for SARS-CoV-2, or any other test for SARS-CoV-2 approved by the Minister of Health) must be administered at a testing site approved by the Minister of Health. Self-administered rapid antigen tests are not accepted.

Attestation

All employees of the Office of the Provincial Auditor are in compliance with the Office's COVID-19 vaccination policy as noted above. Employees are verified as fully vaccinated or have provided proof of a valid negative COVID-19 tests as required.
